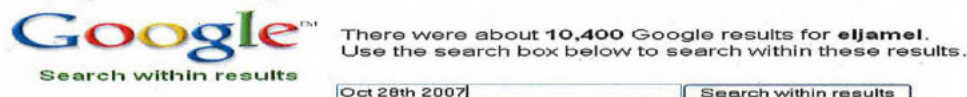

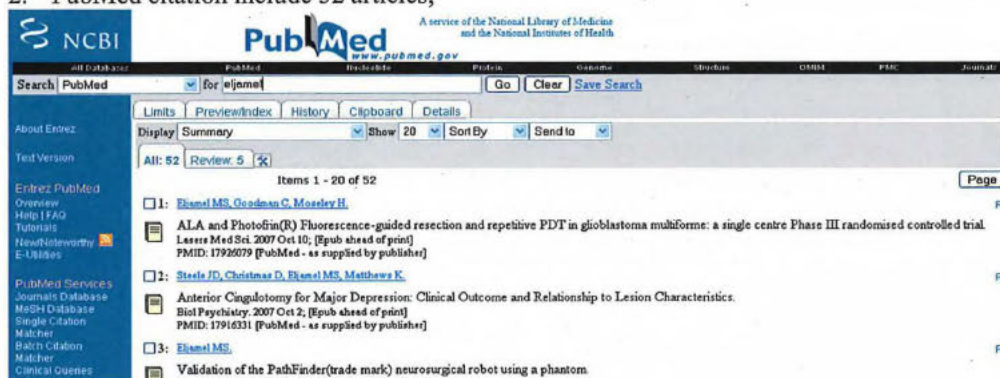

Professor Eljamel, NHS Tayside Brief:

Prof Eljamel is currently under police investigation for the alleged harming of more than 50 Patients during surgery and lied about doing operations. Allegedly, during surgery he was operating on patients and was cutting through tissue down to whatever the patient's problem was and then not carrying out the operation required. Sam is also accused of lying to other medical staff including, senior staff, colleagues and medical students that tried to correct him during surgery before he overrode them with his authority.

Time Line of Events:

First complains against Pro Eljamel where made in mid to late 2000s

- Professor Eljamel – who had been a consultant neurological surgeon at NHS Tayside since 1995.
- June 2013 - Sam Eljamel is put under investigation and under supervision
- August 2013 - Mr Eljamel operates on Jules Rose's tumour
- October 2013 - Royal College of Surgeons interim report on Sam Eljamel
- 6 December 2013 - Royal College of Surgeons final report on Sam Eljamel
- 9 December 2013 - A second procedure by Mr Eljamel is undertaken on Ms Rose
- 10 December 2013 - Mr Eljamel is suspended
- May 2014 - Mr Eljamel retires from NHS Tayside
- Mr Eljamel now lives in the US.

In one case, the BBC has discovered a junior surgeon carried out spinal surgery at the “incorrect spinal level” while “under instruction” from Professor Eljamel. Documents say the junior surgeon “raised concern” about the spinal level, but Professor Eljamel advised him that the “site was correct” and told him to carry on with the operation. The case took place in 2010 – three years before Professor Eljamel was suspended.

Mr Eljamel, while under investigation by NHS Tayside was still allowed to perform surgery. He continued to cause harm to his patients despite being under investigation and supervision. An example of patient endangerment / harm:

‘Marathon runner Jules Rose - diagnosed with a brain tumour - tells the programme that she was operated on by Professor Eljamel in August 2013, a month after he was placed under supervision due to serious concerns about his work.’

‘She says she was initially told the operation had been a success but then discovered the surgeon hadn’t removed her tumour at all - instead he had removed her entire tear gland.’

‘It meant she had to have a second risky operation under Professor Eljamel.

At no point, she says, was she ever told that the surgeon was under supervision or there were concerns about him.’

Professor Eljamel has been accused of giving the impression he is still employed at Ninewells Hospital through his AANS Membership.

The scientific and educational association promotes the “highest quality of patient care” and has more than 10,000 members worldwide.

AANS members need to keep their address “current” and the latest provided by Mr Eljamel, which appears on its database, is Ninewells Hospital.

Membership requires the doctor to “maintain board certification” in the country of residence although Mr Eljamel has been not been able to practise since August 2015.

He also remains an editorial board member of Photodiagnosis and Photodynamic Therapy and Surgical Neurology International which is “committed to meeting and upholding standards of ethical behaviour”.

There have been calls by the public for a public inquiry. For both to investigate NHS Tayside for not spotting and then latter overlooking the actions of Professor Eljamel, in was appears like favouritism and later dangerous denial.

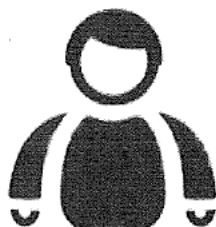

The department was in a purpose built wing in Dundee Royal Infirmary until Nov 13th, 1998 when it moved to the new build on the 6th Floor of the South Block at Ninewells Hospital and Medical School.
